Annual Recurring Tasks

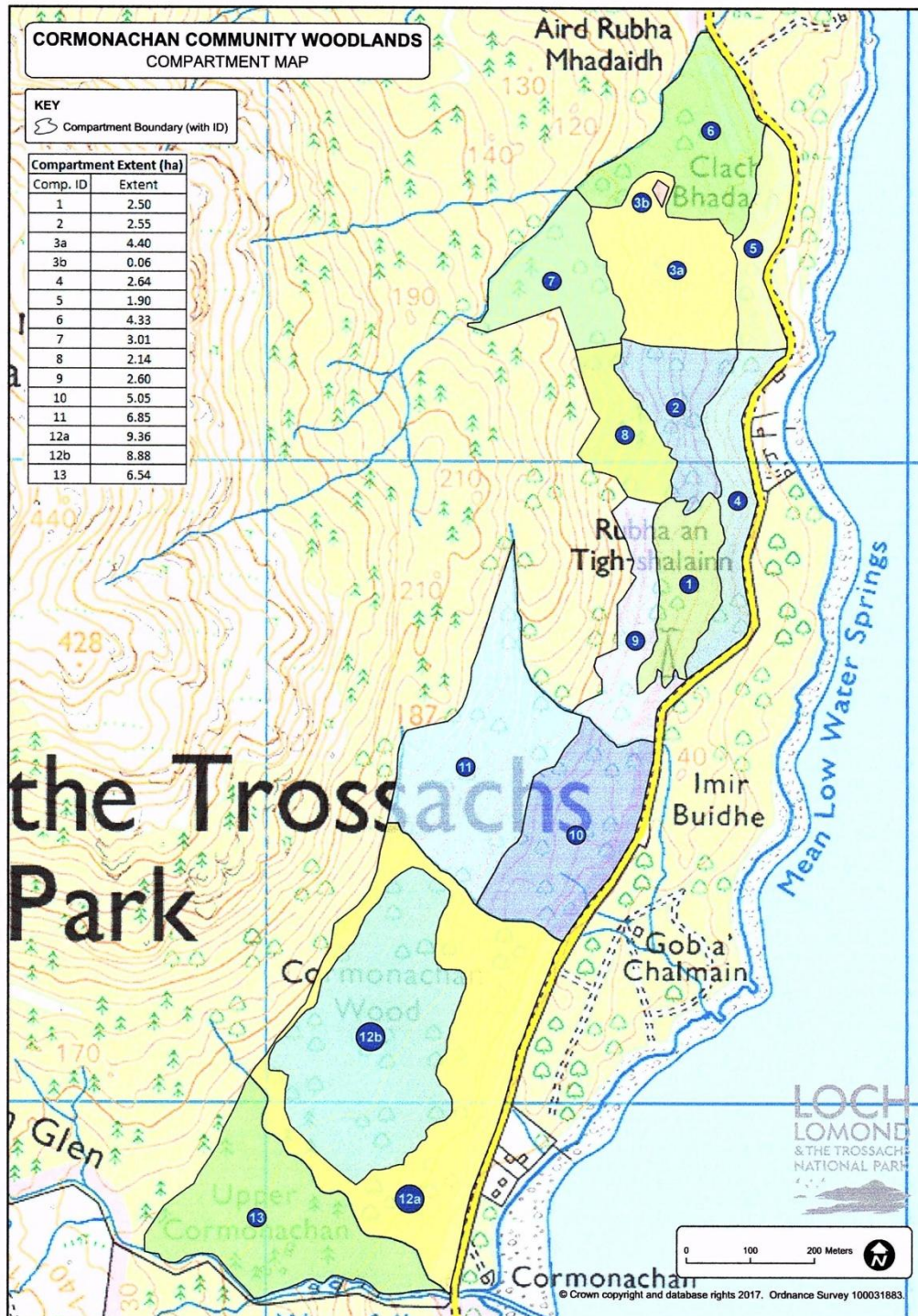
- 1) Removal of Rhododendron ponticum (Action: CCW, Ardroy and by grant)
- 2) Spraying & Injection of Rhododendron ponticum (Action: CCW & by grant)
- 3) Maintenance of existing paths (Action: CCW)
- 4) Maintenance of ditches (Action: CCW)
- 5) Equipment & Tools maintenance in Shed (Action: CCW)
- 6) Maintenance and painting of Contemplation Shelter, Red Squirrel Hide and storage Shed (Action: CCW)
- 7) Annual survey of high risk trees (Action: FLS)
- 8) Top up squirrel feeders all year (Action: CCW)

Annual Project Work (Tree felling subject to SF Permissions)

- 9) 'Upper Cormonachan Paths Project' apply for funding for Autumn 2021 to create 2 km paths extensions (Action: CCW)
- 10) Cut down under planted Sitka spruce over 380 mm in Area 9 in autumn 2021 & spring 2022 (Action: Fife Conservation Group & trained CCW certificated volunteers)
- 11) Cut down up to 5 m³ per quarter of under planted Sitka spruce less than 380mm in spring, summer, autumn & winter (Action: CCW)
- 12) Clear weeds from around planted native trees in Areas 1 & 9 (Action: CCW)
- 13) Clean picnic tables and benches (Action: CCW)

14) Roll logs away from new path route and stack brush for burning in Areas 9, 10 & 12A (Action: CCW)

15) Attempt to ascertain the age of the veteran oak trees (Action: CCW)
