Comment: On behalf of the Friends of Loch Lomond and The Trossachs, the independent conservation and heritage charity covering the National Park, I am writing to confirm our strong support for the extension of the existing Cormonachan woodlands network of paths with the addition of a further 2km of new paths.

We are pleased this latest proposed path will link the existing path network with the spectacular Cormonachan Burn waterfalls and the ruins of the ancient settlement of Upper Cormonachan thus opening up access to some interesting natural and cultural heritage features for the general public to enjoy.

We also support the installation of additional low key signage and interpretation panels as well as the creation of an additional small scale car park.

Given the importance of this proposal in delivering a new recreational and heritage asset in the Cowal part of the National Park some financial assistance will be provided from the Friends of OUR park visitor giving scheme.
