- 1) We would need to know that you have applied for a marriage licence from Samantha Gillies, Argyll & Bute Council, 22 Hill Street, Dunoon, PA23 7AP

- 2) Date & Time of the Marriage to be advised following contact with the Registrar above - Licences take about a month to approve.
- 3) You must follow the Covid-19 Pandemic Regulations with regard to the maximum number of people allowed to attend;
see <https://www.gov.scot/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-guidance-for-small-marriages-and-civil-partnership-registrations/>
Safe distancing of a minimum of 2-metres must be adhered to with the exception of the happy couple of course.
- 4) Whilst we don't charge a fee, we would expect a reasonable donation to be made to our 'Upper Cormonachan Paths Project Fund':-

- 6) We have a policy of 'Leave No Trace' - so nothing must be left behind after the event.
- 7) Special permission to use the Contemplation Shelter for your wedding would be granted on receipt of a copy of your wedding licence with the request for the wedding to be held on a specific date and time.
