- 1) Removal of Rhododendron (Action: CWA & Ardroy)
- 2) Removal of Sitka spruce [less than 10 cm dbh] (Action: Ardroy & CWA)
- 3) Maintenance of existing paths (Action: CWA)
- 4) Maintenance of ditches (Action: CWA & Ardroy)
- 5) Installation of way marker posts (Action: CWA)
- 6) Maintenance of Jan's Hut, Shed and Toilet (Action: Ardroy)
- 7) Removal of high risk trees (Action; FCS)
- 8) Installation of artificial squirrel feeders (Action: Ardroy)
- 9) Provision of site map and aerial photographs of CW (Action: FCS)
- 10) Installation of first natural sculpture in CW (Action: CWA)
- 11) Obtain planning permission for extended car park and construct (Action: CWA)
- 12) Cut down up to 5 m³ of under planted Sitka spruce (Action: Fife ranger volunteers)
- 13) Cut top of largest Sitka spruce tree at south west corner of CW and convert to a totem pole (Action: Ardroy & CWA)
- 14) Clear path at north east corner of CW leading to Lochwood (Action: CWA)
- 15) Plan for a woodlands survey for CW for volunteers (Action: CWA)
- 16) Equipment & Tools maintenance (Action: CWA)
- 17) Cleaning of compost toilet in CW (Action: CWA)
- 18) Prepare 'crib' sheet for Ardroy Instructors (Action: Ardroy & CWA)
