Other News

Trimmer Training Course - We have three members say they are willing to be trained on a one day course in Cormonachan Woodlands but we need one more member to volunteer as the course is for four members. We have 100% funding available from Forestry Commission Scotland Community Fund. The cost of the four person course is £425.00 with no cost to you. If a further two members would like to be trained then we could put on a six person training course and get funding for that one as an alternative. We can't apply for the funding until we have at least four members names so would someone else volunteer please. Your commitment would be to help keep the paths strimmed. We already have six trained strimmer operators but with ten the workload is lightened to about 2 x 2 hours per year.
